PLEASE JOIN THE \$5 WEEKLY CHALLENGE The annual budget for 2025-2026 was approved by the Voters' Assembly and included a \$5 Weekly Challenge that was proposed by the Board of Directors. The goal is for each household of our congregation to increase their offerings by \$5 per week. This challenge has been proposed to fund approximately \$65,000 for ministry and taking care of our staff which we could otherwise not afford due to anticipated lower offerings based on the current trend.
