

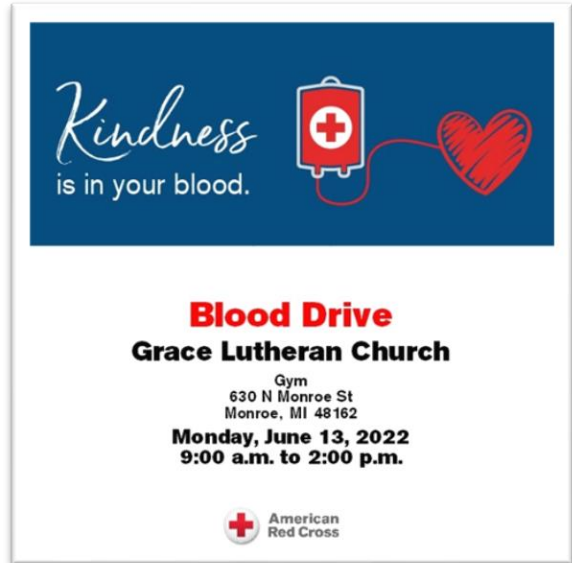

TRINITY QUALIFIES 23 FOR STATE TRACK MEET Trinity was one of 13 schools participating in the Region 2 Track Meet at Concordia University in Ann Arbor on Saturday, May 21. The 4th-6th grade girls won the team championship as fifth grader Charity Frank-DeRoch won the high jump (4'6"), was second in the 800, joined with Lydia Frank-DeRoch, Hannah Finley, and Grace DePalma to place second in the 800 relay, and then teamed up with Lacie Little, Olivia Oetjens, and Kelsie Sikes to take second in the 1600 relay. Lacie was also second in the 1600 and third in the 800. Kelsie also claimed third in the 1600 while Grace was third in the 400 and fifth in the 200. Paige Frank and Ella Sieb went third and fourth in the shot put. Ava Downen was fourth in the 1600 and Lydia was fifth in the high jump.

The 4th-6th grade boys placed third in the team standings. They were led by sixth grader Gavin Rohr who won the 800 (2:40) and took second in both the high jump and the 1600. He also joined up with Jeffery Gessner, Bryce Bellino, and Cole Butler to win the 1600 relay. Jeffery and Bryce teamed up with Noah Aaron and Thomas Vallade to place second in the 800 relay. Jeffery also grabbed third in the 400 while Cole finished third in the 1600 and fifth in the 800. The 400 relay team of Noah, Brendan Sulfaro, Hunter Ball, and Harrison Becker will head to the state meet after finishing fourth. Eighth grader Noah Harmon was second in the high jump and third in both the 800 and 1600 while classmate Samuel-Frank DeRoch placed second in the shot put. Eighth graders Delani Willey (second in the high jump) and Emma Wigman (fourth in the 1600) also qualified for the Lutheran State Track Meet to be held at Valley Lutheran High School in Saginaw on June 4.
