SPECIAL VOTERS' MEETING At our recent Voters' meeting an expenditure of \$80,000 was approved to Kohler Architectural Firm to complete the HVAC System Replacement Engineering Package. This package will determine the best plan to move forward with replacing boilers, chillers and other units that heat and cool our facilities. All are currently in good working order but based on a study recently completed they are all at the end of their useful lives. This is a project that will need to be done in phases, but we are hopeful we can do some work next summer. The payment of \$80,000 was approved to come from ongoing donations to the Strategic Capital Improvement Fund and out of existing reserves. More information will be coming soon about the cost and fundraising efforts for this project, but in the meantime, if you are looking for a place to donate special gifts or memorials, we ask that you would consider this Capital Improvement account.
