**PASTOR CARRIER FAREWELL** This Sunday, June 1, join us for a combined service at 10:00am as we bid farewell and Godspeed to Interim Senior Pastor John Carrier and his wife, Lori. A potluck luncheon will immediately follow the service. Trinity will provide chicken and ham; families with last names beginning with A-H are asked to bring a salad, I-Q a hot dish, and R-Z a dessert. We give thanks to God for Pastor Carrier's willingness to serve at Trinity for 15.5 months as we waited and prepared for a new senior pastor to arrive, and we ask Him to richly bless the Carriers as they depart from us. Please note that there will be no regular 8:30am or 10:30am services on Sunday, June 1, but the 6pm Saturday evening service on May 31 will still be held.

**VOTERS' MEETING UPDATE** The annual budget for 2025-2026 was approved by the Voters' Assembly and included a **\$5 Weekly Challenge** that was proposed by the Board of Directors. The goal is for each household of our congregation to increase their offerings by \$5 per week. This challenge has been proposed to fund approximately \$65,000 for ministry and taking care of our staff which we could otherwise not afford due to anticipated lower offerings based on the current trend.

The financials for the period ending March 31, 2025, were presented and reflected offerings below budget of \$116,000. We do anticipate ending this year (June 30, 2025) in the black due to expenses being lower than budgeted; mainly due to one-time occurrences of lower benefit costs for the senior pastor position and finance hours worked being under the budgeted amount.

Other items approved were

- \$199,000 for the fire alarm system renovation for church and school to be paid for with Strategic Capital Improvement and reserve funds
- Constitution changes
- Peaceful release of Pastor Carrier from his call
- Grants from the Endowment Fund and election of members
- Braille Memo of Understanding
