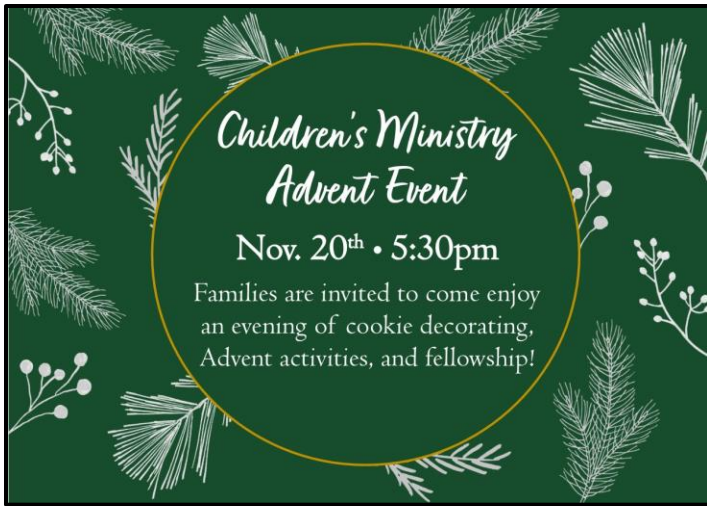
CHRISTMAS GIFTS FOR LOS LIMONES In 2014, Trinity established a partnership with "The Resurrection" Lutheran Church in Gualán, Guatemala. Mission groups visited the church three times to help with water filter projects, English and a Second Language instruction, and erecting a church in the Los Limones community. This church in Los Limones, "The Cross of Christ Forgives", hopes to bless its members in need. Pastor Luis Jasinto has requested Christmas gifts for 160 children (\$10/child suggested), basic foodstuffs for 20 families (\$25/family suggested), and school desks for 25 students at the Lutheran school in Gualán (\$66/desk). We're excited to renew a relationship with our brothers and sisters in Guatemala, and we pray you are, too! Please keep them in prayer and, as you're able, consider a financial gift. We hope to act quickly to ensure that donations are received by Christmas.
