ASSISTANCE FOR DEINZER CLIENTS *A note from Sue Gruber, our Social Ministry Liaison:* Due to the pause of SNAP (Bridge Card – Food Stamps) benefits starting Nov. 1, many families will not have access to adequate nutrition for their household. In Monroe County, 16,026 residents served by SNAP may experience food insecurity (not only families, but senior citizens, too). Since we do have a small food closet for our Deinzer Program applicants and the community, beginning this weekend (Nov. 8th and 9th) we will host a three-week door offering to bless our neighbors in need. Gifts of money or food (canned vegetables, soup, tuna, chicken, cereal, etc.) are welcome. Donations to the Benevolence Fund would be greatly appreciated as well.
