**VOTERS' MEETING UPDATE** The annual budget for 2025-2026 was approved by the Voters' Assembly and included a **\$5 Weekly Challenge** that was proposed by the Board of Directors. The goal is for each household of our congregation to increase their offerings by \$5 per week. This challenge has been proposed to fund approximately \$65,000 for ministry and taking care of our staff which we could otherwise not afford due to anticipated lower offerings based on the current trend. The financials for the period ending March 31, 2025, were presented and reflected offerings below budget of \$116,000. We do anticipate ending this year (June 30, 2025) in the black due to expenses being lower than budgeted; mainly due to one-time occurrences of lower benefit costs for the senior pastor position and finance hours worked being under the budgeted amount. Other items approved included \$199,000 for the fire alarm system renovation for church and school (to be paid for with Strategic Capital Improvement and reserve funds), Constitution changes, the peaceful release of Pastor Carrier from his call, grants from the Endowment Fund and election of members, and the Braille Memo of Understanding.
